Missy has both the knowledge and experience to serve on the School Board. She believes the School Board should:

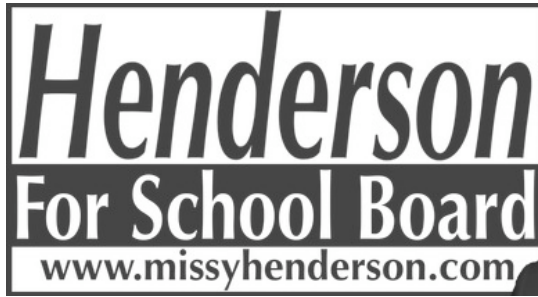
- Promote quality schools to bring people to Beloit and to keep them here.
